- It was decided to conduct an Orientation programme for the newly admitted students in UG and PG courses immediately after the completion of the admissions of the academic year.
- 4. A result analysis of the previous academic year should be done by all the departments and the report should be submitted to IQAC coordinator.
- 5. A Plan of action for the academic year should be collected from every department.
- 6. Decided to offer coaching classes to students for attending competitive examinations such as PSC/UPSC, NEST, JEST, JAM, SET/NET and Bank.
