Reports of Induction Programmes for First Years organized in the last 5 years

Orientation programs for freshers are designed to guide students in answering all their doubts and queries related to the new institution, courses and the entirely new campus atmosphere. Prior to the beginning of classes, students are given an overview of the complete realm of college life, from academics to social activities, through an orientation session. Typically, a staff member or team coordinates the orientation programs. However, regardless of the nature of the program, three objectives should be present in all orientation programs:

- 1) introducing students to college life;
- 2) acclimating students to their new surroundings; and
- 3) providing an opportunity for the staff and senior students to meet the newest members of their community.

Orientation programs begin before classes start. As new students need some direction and guidance in enrolling for classes, faculty members should provide academic advising at orientation. An academic component to orientation will give the new students the advantage they will need in making the transition from high school to college. By giving a strong overview of academic expectations, students will be better prepared to meet the challenges of collegiate academics.

Apart from students, we also respond to the queries and concerns of parents. Because parents can aid in the student's transition into college life, our college considers it a top-end criteria to inform parents as well as students about the structure of the course, syllabus and other services.

Our college organizes orientation/induction programmes every year so that students should be made aware of opportunities to be socially integrated into the college culture.

INDUCTION PROGRAMME FOR FRESHERS (2016-17)

The Induction programmme for freshers was organized on 27 August 2016 with the welcome of the students, their parents, dignitaries, faculty members and Chief Guest of the event Sri Suresh Babu, District Labour Officer. A Saraswati vandanam recital by the students of our Music department was followed by a lamp lighting ceremony. Our principal gave a brief description of the institute, which included the motto, history and reputation of college along with recent achievements. Our chief guest enlightened the audience with his speech and urged the students to pursue education with utmost sincerity.



INDUCTION PROGRAMME FOR FRESHERS (2017-18)

INDUCTION PROGRAMME FOR FRESHERS (2019-20)


